Senior from Pittsburgh, Penn., Chapla has already established the SRU all-time career records for scoring (349 points), field goals made (47) and PATs made (208). He leads all active players in Division II in scoring (349) and made PAT kicks (208). His 208 PAT kicks are the second most among all active players at any level of college football, just one shy of Chase Vinatieri of South Dakota State (FCS) following games of Oct. 26. His 349 points are the most among all active Division II players and are the third most among all active college players at any level, trailing only Georgia kicker Rodrigo Blankenship (379) and Vinatieri (356). Chapla is just 13 points shy of breaking the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference's all-time record for scoring by a kicker. This season, all three of Chapla's missed PAT kicks were blocks after breakdowns along the line. He is also averaging 59.8 yards per kickoff on 68 kickoffs with 21 touchbacks.
