It is a pleasure to recognize kickers that were nominated by their schools for terrific performances as we welcome back college football.

- Collegiate Division – 2 FCS, 1 Division II, 2 Division III, 1 NAIA, and 1 NJCAA
- State – the place-kickers play at schools located in 6 different states
- Year – 3 Seniors, 1 Junior, 1 Sophomore, and 2 Freshmen

Senior from Nogales, Ariz., is excited for his first full season after being named Fred Mitchell Outstanding Place Kicker for 2019 ... made the longest field goal in the FCS in 2019 (and would be tied for longest in FBS) with a career-long 57-yard boot in win over Northern Colorado (Oct. 5, 2019)... 90 percent success rate on field goal attempts ... continues to establish himself as a leader on the squad with his dedications and work ethic...is a regular volunteer in the community having spent time this offseason dedicating his time to efforts to help assist the Flagstaff community following the “Museum Fire” in August of 2019 filling sandbags to be utilized in flood and fire prevention efforts...assisted the Salvation Army in their annual “Back

to School Buddy” program where he partnered with a local child to help him pick out clothes and supplies for the upcoming school year.

Only two field goal misses were blocked kicks...Finished second on the team in scoring with 33 total points ... Second Tiger in three years to not miss an extra point attempt all season along with Michael Baugus in 2018 ... Averaged 54.8 yards per kickoff (31 total kickoffs for 1,700 yards) with one touchback...Helped Northeast finish as the 2020 MACCC North Division runner-up with a final national ranking of No. 13 ... Made a season-long 32-yard field goal in a road win over Mississippi Delta...Extensive community service resume as a member of the Eagle Scouts ... Helped local chapters of the Red Cross and Rotary

Club with fundraisers during the pandemic in 2020...Assisted with Vacation Bible School activities at area churches from 2017-20...Volunteered at the annual Coca-Cola 5K Race in Corinth, Miss., from 2012-19 ... Senior from Waverly, Neb., Nielsen is entering this season having been named Second Team All-Conference selection at the kicker position for DSU ... he made a career-best 53-yard field goal at Waldorf (Iowa) on Nov. 7, 2020 ... He converted 21-of-22 PAT extra-point kicks and was second on the team in scoring with 39 points...Nielsen ranked 18th in total field goals (6), 26th in total scoring (kicking) (39).

The senior from Lockhart, Texas ... Continued to establish himself as not one of the best kickers in the American Southwest Conference (ASC) but all of Division III over the course of his shortened junior season ... finished in the top five in all of NCAA Division III in: field goal percentage with a minimum of 6 FGs attempted (second), field goals attempted (third), field goals per game (third) ... tied his career long with a 44 yard boot in a loss against East Texas Baptist (Mar.27) ... was a perfect 7-7 on field goals 45 yards and under last season ... in addition to a made 22-yard field goal and two touchbacks on kickoffs - he was a perfect 4-for-4 on extra points in season opening win over Howard Payne (Feb.6) ... drilled lone 34-yard field goal attempt in win over Sul Ross State and averaged 52-yards on five kickoffs (Feb. 27) ... perfect two for two on extra points in loss against Hardin-Simmons (Mar. 6) ... drilled 3 out of 4 field goal attempts and was 6-for-6 on extra points in win against McMurry (Mar. 13) ... was perfect 2-for-2 on field goal attempts including tying his career long with a 44-yarder in loss against East Texas Baptist (Mar. 27) ... was honored as American Southwest Conference Special Teams Player of the Week once last season...named First-Team All-American by D3Football.com ... named First Team All-ASC for the 2020-21 season ... named to the 2020-21 First-Team Academic All-District® 8 Football Team for NCAA Division III ... named ASC Academic All-Conference for

the 2nd consecutive season ... named to the American Southwest Conference's Distinguished Scholar-Athlete Football Team ... named to the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America® First Team for NCAA Division III Football ... been an example student-athlete off the field and in the classroom holding a 3.74 GPA as a biochemistry major...

Got his Bachelor's Degree in 3 years and is now working on MBA for forensic accounting, (listed as Junior on Roster for 2021 season) ... has been MEC Conference Player-of-the-Week 5 times, earned 2-time All MEC Conference Honors, 2018 NCAA DII All Super Regional One Team, has been consistently in the NCAA Top-10 for kicking accuracy each season (2019 he only had 10 attempts, so that dropped him off list, he was 9/10 that season). He is currently 25 for 29 in his first 3 seasons (2021 WLU played 4 games for a shortened 2020 “Spring” season).
